

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 441

AN ORDINANCE, declaring an emergency in the Current Expense Fund (Police Department) under the general classes, Salaries and Wages, Maintenance and Operation, and Capital Outlay; providing for an expenditure in excess of the estimated expenditures in said fund and classes; and providing for the issuance of emergency warrants.

WHEREAS, population increases in excess of that anticipated at the time the budget estimates for 1967 were made, together with a general increase in the demands upon the police department in this developing urban area, have taxed the ability of the City to provide proper police protection with its present equipment and police force; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that an emergency therefore exists in the ability of the City to provide proper police protection and that such condition can be alleviated by the expenditure of funds in the estimated amount of \$13,880.00 for the purchase of a patrol unit and equipment, to employ two additional patrolmen, and for necessary expenses of maintenance and operation in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, the 1967 Washington State Legislature did appropriate funds for cities and towns to assist them with problems faced in furnishing police and fire protection and providing for public parks, which funds will provide assistance in meeting the emergency described above, but will not be sufficient to meet the required expenditure in full; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That an emergency is hereby declared to exist which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time the estimates were made for the 1967 Budget, requiring an expenditure of \$13,880.00 in funds not provided for in said Budget; and the expenditure of \$13,880.00 is hereby authorized and appropriated out of the Current Expense Fund (Police Department) under the general classes Salaries and Wages, Maintenance and Operation, and Capital Outlay in order to provide for said emergency, as follows:

Police Department	\$8,258.00	\$2,009.00	\$3,613.00

Section 2. Said emergency expenditure shall be paid by the issuance of emergency warrants, to be paid from any moneys on hand in the City Treasury in the Current Expense Fund not otherwise appropriated, including unanticipated revenues received from the appropriation of the 1967 Washington State Legislature for cities and towns, or if there be insufficient money on hand in such fund, such warrants shall be registered and shall bear interest at the rate of 5% per annum until called for and paid.

Section 3. The publication of a copy of this Ordinance prior to its adoption as required by RCW 35.33.090 shall constitute

publication of the Ordinance under the requirements of RCW 35.24.220, provided no changes have been made in the proposed Ordinance upon its adoption.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 1967.


