

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 446

AN ORDINANCE, establishing salaries and wages for employees of the Police Department; and amending Ordinance No. 414 in such regard.

WHEREAS, the City Council authorized an emergency appropriation for the Police Department pursuant to Ordinance No. 441, passed June 27, 1967, which included provision for an increase in the salaries and wages scale for employees of the Police Department, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following salaries and wages scale is hereby established and adopted for the respective positions of the employees of the Police Department of the City of Redmond.


<u>Position</u>	<u>Salary or Wage Range</u>
Lieutenant	\$690.00 - \$720.00 monthly
Sergeant (2)	635.00 - 685.00 "
Patrolman, 1st	590.00 - 620.00 "
Patrolman, 2nd	540.00 - 585.00 "
Patrolman, 3rd	510.00 - 535.00 "
Policewoman	400.00 - 450.00 "
Radio Operator	2.10 - 2.40 hourly

Section 2. To the extent that this ordinance modifies the salaries and wages scale therein established, Ordinance No. 414, passed December 27, 1966, is hereby amended accordingly.


Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.
