

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 450

AN ORDINANCE, adopting the Budget for the City of Redmond for the year 1968; making appropriations for estimated expenditures; and fixing the amount of taxes to be levied.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Budget adopted. The Budget for the City of Redmond for the calendar year 1968 (which is also the fiscal year) is hereby approved and adopted in the aggregate total sum of \$710,248.00 as determined and filed with the City Clerk this date, following a public hearing held thereon in the manner and as provided by law. Such Budget is exclusive of the budget for the waterworks utility of the City, which does not involve any tax levy and will be adopted separately as a functional-type budget.

Section 2. Appropriations. There is hereby appropriated from estimated revenues, including available surplus, revenues from taxation, and revenues from all other sources, the following amounts for expenditures in each of the following general classes for the budget year 1968 (exclusive of the waterworks utility of the City) as follows:

(1) Salaries and Wages	\$231,285.00
(2) Maintenance and Operation	231,820.00
(3) Capital Outlay	178,418.00
(4) Interest and Debt Redemption	68,725.00
(5) Expenditures from Proposed Bond Issues	<u>-0-</u>
TOTAL APPROPRIATIONS	<u><u>\$710,248.00</u></u>

NOTE: Does not include appropriations for waterworks utility.

Section 3. Taxes levied. There is hereby levied upon all taxable property, both real and personal, within the City of Redmond, King County, Washington, for general taxation purposes and voted excess levies for general obligation bond issues, a tax levy for the year 1968, as follows:

General Tax Levy	15.000 mills
Excess Tax Levy: Redmond Limits 1	2.824 mills
Redmond Limits 3	2.562 mills

Section 4. Copies of Budget. Copies of the detailed and itemized Budget adopted for the year 1968 hereby shall be kept on file at the office of the City Clerk and shall be available for inspection by any interested taxpayer of the City.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof as established by law, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 3rd day of October, 1967.
