CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 457

AN ORDINANCE, relating to meetings of the City Council; amending Section 1 of Ordinance No. 283; and repealing Ordinance No. 440.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 283, passed March 28, 1962, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Regular Meetings. Regular meetings of the City Council of the City of Redmond shall be held on the first, second and third Tuesdays of each month at 7:30 P.M., beginning Tuesday, **\frac{1968}{1968}*; provided, however, that should any such meeting fall upon a day designated as a legal holiday, such meeting shall be held at the same hour on the next succeeding business day not a holiday, excluding Saturdays and Sundays; provided, further, that the hour set for such meetings shall be 8:00 P.M. instead of 7:30 P.M. during the period established by RCW 1.20.051 for daylight saving time.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 440, passed May 23, 1967, is hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3.</u> This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.
