CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 460

AN ORDINANCE, relating to plumbing and plumbing systems including lawn sprinkler systems; and amending Section 1, Ordinance No. 443.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 443, adopted June 13, 1967, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Plumbing Code. There is hereby adopted by the City of Redmond, for the purpose of establishing rules and regulations for the construction, alteration, repair, maintenance and operation of plumbing and plumbing systems including lawn sprinkler systems, and their incidents, that certain document and code known as the Plumbing Code adopted by the City of Seattle by its Ordinance No. 92190, as amended by its Ordinance Nos. 95168 and 96281, three (3) copies of which have been filed and shall be kept on file with the City Clerk, and the same is hereby adopted by this reference thereto and incorporated herein as fully as though set out in length herein, except such portions as may be deleted, modified or amended by this ordinance; and from the effective date of this ordinance, the provisions thereof shall be controlling within the limits of the City of Redmond.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of the publication of this ordinance in the manner provided by law.
