ordinance no. 464

AN ORDINANCE, vacating a portion of N.E. 65th Street, within the City of Redmond, Washington

WHEREAS, a written Petition for the Vacation of Street, signed by in excess of two-thirds of the property owners abutting thereon, was filed with the City Clerk and presented to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council by Resolution No. 198 set the date of March 12, 1968, at 8:00 P.M., at the City Hall, before the City Council, as the time, place and authority for a public hearing to be held on said Petition; and

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of such hearing has been made in accordance with law; and

WHEREAS, the hearing having been duly held, there being no objections by any of the abutting property owners, and the City Council having determined that it is in the best interest of the City and the property owners concerned that such street and public way be vacated, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the petition be granted, and the following described street and public way is hereby declared vacated:

That portion of N.E. 65th Street which lies between the west boundary and the east boundary of the east half of the south-west quarter of section 10, township 25 north, range 5 east, W.M. (AKA N.E. 65th Street of Keystone Addition and Supplemental Plat of Keystone Addition, a vacated plat.)

Situated in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.
