## CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON ORDINANCE NO. 467

AN ORDINANCE, relating to certain crimes and offenses; prohibiting the intentional inhalation of fumes from certain glues, cements and adhesives or the sale thereof to minors without authorization by parent or legal guardian; and providing penalties for violations.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to intentionally smell or inhale the fumes from any glue, cement, or any other adhesive containing one or more of the following chemical compounds: acetone, acetate, benezine, butyl alcohol, ethyl alcohol, athylene, dicholride, isopropyl alcohol, methyl ethyl ketone, pentachlorophenol, petroleum ether or toluene, for the purpose of becoming intoxicated, inebriated, excited or stupified; Provided, this section shall not be construed as applying to the inhalation of any anesthetic or medical or dental purposes.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, merchant or retailer to sell any of the products specified in Section 1 to any person under the age of eighteen years unless such person has a written authorization signed by his parent or legal guardian to purchase any of said products, which authorization shall contain information concerning the type, quantities and intended use of the product, the name and age of the minor, and the name and ageross of the parent or legal guardian.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or by imprisonment in jail for not to exceed six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force fire (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.
