

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 488

AN ORDINANCE, vacating a portion of N.E. 70th Street, within the City of Redmond, Washington.

WHEREAS, a written request for the Vacation of Street by some of the property owners abutting thereon, was received by the City and presented to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by Resolution No. 212, initiated procedures pursuant to RCW 35.79.010 to consider the vacation of said street and set the date of March 4, 1969, at 8:00 P.M., at the City Hall, before the City Council, as the time, place and authority for a public hearing to be held on said Petition; and

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of such hearing has been made in accordance with law; and

WHEREAS, the hearing having been duly held, there being no objections by any of the abutting property owners, and the City Council having determined that it is in the best interest of the City and the property owners concerned that such street and public way be vacated, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Petition be granted, and the following described street and public way is hereby declared vacated:

The north 30 feet of the west half of the southwest quarter of section 10, township 25 north, range 5 east, W.M.; except the west 748.85 feet of said north 30 feet.

Situated in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington.

Provided, That the City of Redmond hereby reserves for itself and for the public, an easement for the installation, use and maintenance of overhead and underground utilities over, across and under said 30 foot strip of land. No permanent structures or buildings shall be permitted within the easement reserved which will interfere with the use, maintenance, relocation or removal of installed utilities.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 11 of March, 1969.
