## CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ordinance no. 490

AN ORDINANCE, relating to the business of taxicabs and conveyances of persons for hire and the licensing thereof; and amending Section 5.16.040 of the Redmond Municipal Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5.16.000 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to own or operate any motor vehicle for hire such as taxicabs, or any other vehicle for the transportation or conveyance of persons for hire upon any of the streets or public ways of the city without having first obtained a license from the city and having paid a license fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per year for each cab and ten dollars (\$10.00) per year for each driver. The license shall be for the calendar year in which issued, shall not be pro-rated for any portion of the year, and shall not be transferrable either as to cab or as to driver licensed.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.
