## CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 49/

AN ORDINANCE, relating to animal control and the licensing of dogs; and amending Section 7.04.020 of the Redmond Municipal Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 7.04.020 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

All dogs kept, harbored or maintained by their owners or persons having their custody within the city shall be licensed and registered each year on a calendar year basis if over four months of age. Annual dog licenses shall be issued by the City Clerk upon payment of a license fee of three dollars (\$3.00) for each dog. A late charge of two dollars (\$2.00) shall be imposed in addition to the basic charge, for any license application made after January 31 of the calendar year in which the dog was required to be licensed or for any license application made after thirty (30) days of the date the dog first became subject to the dog license requirement. The owner shall state upon printed forms provided by the city at the time application is made for the license, his name, address and resident telephone number, and the name, breed, color, sex and age (or approximate birthdate) of each dog owned or kept by him. The provisions of this section shall not be intended to apply to dogs whose owners are nonresidents temporarily within the city, nor to dogs brought into the city for the purpose of participating in any dog show or exhibition, nor to seeingeye dogs properly trained to assist blind persons when the dogs are actually being used by blind persons for the purpose of aiding them in going from place to place.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.
