ORDINANCE NO. 494

AN ORDINANCE, relating to the City Planning Commission; and providing for declaring a vacancy in office upon certain absences.


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby added to chapter 2.28 of the Redmond Municipal Code a new section to read as follows:

"Absence from meetings - vacancy. If a member of the Planning Commission absents himself from three consecutive regular meetings thereof or fails to attend at least seventy-five percent of regularly scheduled meetings thereof during any twelve month period, unless by prior permission or arrangement of the Commission, his office may be declared vacant by the Commission. Provided, that if the Commission fails to take action to declare his office vacant, the Mayor with the approval of the City Council may declare the office vacant."


Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.
