

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 508

AN ORDINANCE, adopting a supplemental budget for 1969 for the Planning Department in connection with a planning study under a federal assistance grant; and establishing salaries and wages in connection therewith.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond has received approval for a planning assistance grant from the Urban Renewal Administration, as authorized by Section 701, Federal Housing Act of 1954, as amended, which is administered through the Planning and Community Affairs Agency of the State of Washington, under authority of Chapter 74, Laws 1967 (Ex. Sess.), under project number Washington P-165-2; and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates receiving \$20,000 of such planning assistance grant during its fiscal year 1969, which constitutes revenues to the City which were not anticipated at the time the 1969 Budget was adopted by Ordinance No, 473, and it is necessary for the operation of the planning study that these funds be appropriated for the year 1969 as a supplement to the 1969 Budget; and

WHEREAS, it is also necessary to establish salaries and wages for staff members, planners and employees who will be participating in the planning study, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Supplemental Budget for Planning Department adopted. There is hereby adopted a Supplemental Budget for the City of Redmond for the Planning Department, in connection with a planning study under a federal assistance grant, for the months of July through December, 1969, as the same has been determined and filed with the City Clerk, which shall be a supplement to the 1969 Budget adopted under Ordinance No. 473.

Section 2. Appropriations. There is hereby appropriated from the assets and unanticipated revenues received in connection with the planning study from the federal assistance grant, the following expenditures for the budget year 1969, as a supplement to the 1969 Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 473:

Section 3. Copies of Supplemental Budget. Copies of the detailed

and itemized Supplemental Budget hereby adopted for 1969 shall be kept on file at the office of the City Clerk and shall be available for inspection by any interested taxpayer.

Section 4. Salaries and Wages. The following salaries and wages scale is hereby adopted and established for the respective positions in the Planning Department in connection with the planning study under the federal assistance grant:

Planning Department

Senior Planner	\$11,000-12,000/year
Associate Planner	9,500-10,500/year
Assistant Planner (Part Time)	3.00-4.00/hour

The Planning Director shall have the authority and discretion to determine the actual salary or wage to be paid within the range and position indicated, based upon experience, ability, performance and other qualifications for the position; provided, that the gross salaries do not exceed the budgeted amount for the department.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor Pro Tem this 2nd day of December, 1969.


