ORDINANCE NO. 510

AN ORDINANCE, establishing salaries and wages for officials and employees of the City of Redmond; and repealing Ordinance ~~478~~, ~~479~~.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following salaries and wages scale is hereby adopted and established for the respective offices, departments and positions of the officials and employees of the City of Redmond:

Where a range is shown for a particular salary or wage, the appointing authority or department head shall have the authority and discretion to determine the actual salary or wage to be paid within the range and position indicated, based upon experience, ability, performance and other qualifications for the position; provided the gross salaries do not exceed the budgeted amount for the department.

Section 2. Ordinance No: 479, passed December 17, 1968, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. The appointing authority and department heads shall certify to the City Clerk the salaries and wages to be paid to officials and employees under their jurisdiction pursuant to this ordinance, giving the name of the recipient, the title, office or position held, and the salary or wage established; provided, that the salaries and wages of members of the police, ^{and fire} department under civil service shall also be approved by the Civil Service Commission pursuant to RCW 41.12.120 and RCW 41.08.120.


Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 1970, and the salaries and wages scale herein established shall take effect and be in force as of that date.
