ordinance no. 516

AN ORDINANCE, providing for the establishment and operation of the Fireman's Relief and Pension System within the City of Redmond; and establishing the membership of the Fireman's Pension Board therefor.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond has recently employed a fulltime Chief and four paid firemen for the City Fire Department and desires to establish a Fireman's Relief and Pension System and to establish the membership of the Fireman's Pension Board; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A fireman's relief and pension system is hereby declared to have been established and created for the full time paid firemen, including the Chief, of the Fire Department of the City of Redmond as of December 22, 1969 and the Fireman's Pension Board thereby created shall consist of the following five members: ex officio, the Mayor, who shall be chairman of the Board, the City Clerk, the City Treasurer, and in addition two regularly employed firemen elected by secret ballot of the firemen. The first members to be elected by the firemen shall be for a term of one and two years, respectively, determined by lot, and their successors shall be elected annually for a two year term.

Section 2. Except as provided in Section 1., the Fireman's Relief and Pension System shall be administered and operated under the provisions of and in compliance with the applicable laws of the State of Washington.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, AND APPROVED by the Mayor Pro Tem this 6 day of January, 1970.
