

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 521

AN ORDINANCE, relating to and regulating motor vehicles, traffic, travel and transportation and their incidents upon the public streets and ways open to travel; and establishing maximum speed limits and restricted parking upon certain streets.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The maximum speed limits set forth in the schedule of speed limits are hereby established as the reasonable and safe maximum speed limits to be effective at all times upon the streets and highways therein listed and described.

The city traffic engineer, in conjunction with state highway authorities upon streets forming a part of the state highway system, shall cause appropriate signs to be erected on such streets and highways, giving notice of the altered speed limit, as provided in section 10.04.050 of the Redmond Municipal Code.

Section 2. In order to relieve traffic congestion and facilitate the orderly movement and safety of traffic, as provided in

section 10.52.170 of the Redmond Municipal Code, the stopping, standing and parking of vehicles is hereby restricted upon the following street:

166th Ave. N.E.	Both	N.E. 80th St.	N.E. 104th St.	No parking any time

Section 3. This ordinance and the speed and parking restrictions set forth above, shall be in addition to and as a supplement to the Traffic Code (Title 10, Redmond Municipal Code).

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 17 day of March, 1970.


