

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 530

AN ORDINANCE, relating to and regulating motor vehicles, traffic and transportation and their incidents upon the public streets and ways open to travel; and establishing maximum speed limits upon certain streets.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The maximum speed limits set forth in the following schedule are hereby established as the reasonable and safe maximum speed limits to be effective at all times upon the streets and highways therein listed and described.


<u>Highway/Street Designation</u>	<u>Traffic Direction</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>	<u>Maximum Speed</u>
140th Ave. N.E.	Both Ways	S. City Limits	Redmond-Kirkland Rd. (SR 901)	35 mph
N.E. 116th St.	Both Ways	Sammamish River	Willows Rd.	35 mph

Section 2. This ordinance and the speed limits set forth in Section 1. hereof, shall be in addition to and as a supplement to the Traffic Code (Title 10, Redmond Municipal Code).

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 5th day of May, 1970.


