## CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON ORDINANCE NO. 54/

AN ORDINANCE, establishing a library board of trustees, providing for the appointment of members thereto and their terms of office; and prescribing the duties, powers and authority thereof.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Establishment of Library Board - Qualifications. A

Library Board of Trustees is hereby created and established, which
shall consist of five members, who shall be appointed by the Mayor,
subject to the confirmation by a majority vote of the City Council,
all of whom shall be residents of the City of Redmond at the time
of their appointment and during their tenure of office. Appointments shall be made from citizens of recognized fitness for the
position and shall be selected without respect to political
affiliations, race or sex. Members shall not receive a salary or
other compensation for services as trustee, but necessary expenses
actually incurred shall be paid from the library funds.

Section 2. Term of Office - Vacancies - Removal. The members of the Library Board of Trustees shall hold office for a term of five years, commencing on the first date of January, except that first appointments shall be for terms of one, two, three, four and five years respectively, as determined by the appointing authority. Thereafter, as each term expires, appointments shall be made for a five-year term. No person shall be appointed for more than two consecutive terms. Vacancies shall be filled for unexpired terms as soon as possible in the manner in which members of the board are regularly chosen. Members may be removed, after a public hearing, by the City Council for inefficiency, neglect of duty, malfeasance in office, or incapacity.

Section 3. <u>Powers and Duties.</u> The Library Board of Trustees shall have all the powers and perform all the duties as provided by the laws of the State of Washington in RCW 27.12.210 and in RCW 35A.27.010.

They shall also act in an advisory capacity to the Mayor and City Council regarding the operation of a municipal library, and shall make periodic reports and recommendations concerning the acquisition, use, and operation of library facilities and services.

Section 4.	Effective Date: This ordinance shall take effect and
