

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 550

AN ORDINANCE, relating to parks and park property and naming a 40-acre park as the Jonathon E. Hartman Park in commemoration of many years of faithful service to the City of Redmond.

WHEREAS, Jonathon E. Hartman has devoted many years of unselfish, dedicated and loyal service to the City of Redmond and its many functions, departments, and areas of public service; and has been recognized on numerous occasions as having made a valuable and lasting contribution to the growth, development and betterment of the City during a period when Redmond progressed from a small town to a rapidly expanding City; and

WHEREAS, the Redmond Park Board and Redmond Planning Commission have recommended that the 40-acre park on N.E. 104th Street be given the name of Jonathon E. Hartman Park in commemoration of such valuable public service, and the City Council has considered such recommendations and wholeheartedly endorses and approves the naming of this park for such purposes; NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That the following described park of the City of Redmond be named and designated as "JONATHON E. HARTMAN PARK" in commemoration of many years of faithful and valuable public service rendered by Mr. Hartman for the City of Redmond and its citizens and in grateful acknowledgment of his contribution to the growth and development of the City of Redmond, such park property being bounded on the north by N.E. 104th Street, on the west by 172nd Avenue N.E., on the south by N.E. 100th Street and on the east by 176th Avenue N.E., and being described as follows:

The southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of section 36, township 26 north, range 5 east, W.M., situated in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, AND APPROVED by the Mayor this 16 day of March, 1971.


