

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 560

AN ORDINANCE, annexing a portion of the right-of-way along 148th Avenue N.E. to the City of Redmond under Annexation No. 71-A-1; and providing that such territory shall subject to the jurisdiction of the City of Redmond from and after the effective date of this ordinance.

WHEREAS, a portion of 148th Avenue N.E. as hereafter described, forms a contiguous boundary between the cities of Redmond and Bellevue, and following discussions between the respective cities, the City of Bellevue by its Resolution No. 1789, passed March 22, 1971, initiated a proposed annexation of the east half of the right-of-way of said street to the City of Redmond; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Redmond by its Resolution No. 266, passed April 6, 1971, accepted the proposal to adjust this common boundary and declared its intent to accept an annexation of the easterly half of the right-of-way along 148th Avenue N.E. then lying within the limits of the City of Bellevue so that this area would then be within the limits of the City of Redmond and subject to its jurisdiction and control, including without limitation its police power and zoning control; and

WHEREAS, certified copies of the resolutions by the respective cities of Bellevue and Redmond were duly forwarded and filed with the King County Boundary Review Board, along with other documents as required by RCW Chapter 36.93, and the Chairman of the Board, acting pursuant to RCW 36.93.110, executed a waiver of review of the proposed boundary adjustment and right-of-way annexation, thereby authorizing the respective cities involved to proceed to effect the same; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue adopted its Ordinance No. 1720 on September 27, 1971, deleting from the territorial limits of the City of Bellevue a portion of the right-of-way along 148th Avenue N.E. effective upon the annexation of such portion by the City of Redmond in order to effect an adjustment of the boundary between the respective cities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Redmond, having duly considered the proposed adjustment of boundaries and finding the annexation of such territory to be for the general benefit and welfare of the City of Redmond and the area to be annexed, and finding there are no qualified electors residing within the area to be annexed, and that such area may be annexed to the City of Redmond in accordance with the procedures authorized by RCW 35.10.217(2) and (3) and RCW 35.10.265; NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Annexation of portion of 148th Avenue N.E. The following described territory, situated in King County, Washington, is hereby annexed to the City of Redmond, Washington, to wit:

The west 30.00 feet of Section 26, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M. in King County, Washington, lying north of the south margin of vacated Northeast 18th Place (C. B. Howard Rd.) also that portion of 148th Avenue Northeast lying within sections 14 and 23, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M.,


being the easterly portion of the right-of-way of 148th Avenue N.E., and shall be a part of the limits and shall be subject to the jurisdiction and control of the City of Redmond, including without limitation the police powers and zoning control of the City of Redmond.

Section 2. Certified copies to be furnished. The City Clerk shall prepare and file certified copies of this ordinance with the Office of the County Executive, King County, Washington, and shall obtain and file in duplicate with the State Census Board the required certificate relating to determining the population of the annexed. The Clerk shall also transmit certified copies of this ordinance to the Secretary of State, the Planning and Community Affairs Agency of the State of Washington, and the City Clerk of Bellevue.


Section 3. Effective date. The above-described territory shall become a part of the City of Redmond on and after the 1st day of November, 1971.
