

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 561

AN ORDINANCE, relating to license fees for machines used for playing games of skill for commercial purposes; and amending Section 5.40.040 of the Redmond Municipal Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5.40.040 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.40.040 Fees-Transferability. Each license shall be issued for a period of one year subject to the payment of the monthly license fee for each machine or device as follows: twelve dollars and fifty cents per month per machine or device.

No license shall be transferred from one machine or device to the other, and no machine or device which is licensed shall be transferred from one location to another except with the consent of the city council.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.
