

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 563 -

AN ORDINANCE, establishing salaries and wages for certain officials and employees of the City of Redmond; and amending Ordinance No. 546 in such regard.

WHEREAS, recent changes and additions made in the operation of the Redmond Fire Department make it necessary to establish a Part Paid Firefighters credit and pay procedure for sleepers and to provide a uniform method of paying and assigning credits to the members participating in the sleeper program; Now, Therefore, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Each Part Paid Firefighter of the Redmond Fire Department shall be paid and credited for shifts, response to emergency alarms and extra hours worked in accordance with the following schedule:

- (A) Fire alarms - - - - - 4 credits
Aid calls - - - - - 4 credits
Auto accidents - - - - - 4 credits
Service calls - - - - - 4 credits
Overtime every 15 min work - 1 credit
Officer shift - - - - - \$6.00
Driver shift - - - - - \$5.50
Pipeman shift - - - - - \$5.00
- (B) Sleeper shifts start at 1930 hours daily except December 24th and that shift starts at 2300 hours. The shift terminates at 0600 hours, however if the Part Paid Firefighters are on an emergency alarm at 0600 hours their alarms credit shall not end until 0800 hours.
- (C) Any Part Paid Firefighter failing to report for an assigned shift shall forfeit the previous thirty (30) days credits and shift pay.
- (D) On November 30th of each year the credits earned by the Part Paid Firefighters will be totaled and divided into the amount in the budget allocated for the purpose of paying Part Paid Firefighters, less amount paid for assigned shifts, to determine what each credit is worth. He will then

be paid on the basis of credits earned and assigned shifts worked. He will be paid on the first regular pay period for the month of December each year.


- (E) Anyone terminating before November each year will be paid based on the previous year's credit value.
- (F) At no time will a credit be worth more than one dollar (\$1.00).

Section 2. To the extent that this ordinance modifies the salaries and wages scale therein established, Ordinance No. 546, passed December 15, 1970, is hereby amended accordingly.


Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof and APPROVED by the Mayor this 19th day of October, 1971.


