ORDINANCE NO. 566

AN ORDINANCE, relating to salaries and wages; revising compensation for off-duty court appearances for police officers; and amending Ordinance No. 546 in such regard.

WHEREAS, through inadvertance the sum of \$25.00 per month instead of \$28.00 per month for off-duty court appearances for police officers was inserted in the Salary and Wage Schedule - 1971, attached to and made a part of Ordinance No. 546, although the latter sum was budgeted for and has been actually paid for off-duty court attendance for police officers since the first of the year, Now, Therefore, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The sum of \$28.00 per month is hereby set and established as the compensation for off-duty court appearances for police officers of the Redmond Police Department, retroactive to January 1, 1971, and any and all payment to police officers made at such rate from and after January 1, 1971, to date is hereby ratified, approved and confirmed.

Section 2. To the extent that this ordinance modifies the salaries and wages scale therein established, Ordinance No. 546, passed December 15, 1970, is hereby amended accordingly.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 16 day of November, 1971.


