ORDINANCE NO. 571

AN ORDINANCE, relating to salaries and wages for officials and employees of the City of Redmond; and amending Ordinance No. 569 by the addition of a new section thereto.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Ordinance 569, adopted December 7, 1971, is hereby amended by the addition of a new section thereto:

Section 3.5 Approval of collective bargaining representative required. No salary or wage increase, change or other adjustment shall go into effect or be paid to members of the Police Department who are included as a part of the certified collective bargaining unit recognized by Resolution No. 274, without the prior agreement of the exclusive bargaining representative being first filed with the City Clerk.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby found and declared to be a public emergency ordinance necessary for the protection of the public welfare, credit and property of the City of Redmond and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval as provided by RCW 35A.12.130.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 4th day of January, 1972.
