ORDINANCE NO. 605

AN ORDINANCE, establishing salaries and wages for certain officials and employees of the City of Redmond; and amending Ordinance No. 569 in such regard.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following salaries and wages are hereby established for those offices, departments and positions of officials and employees of the City of Redmond for the pay period beginning December 16, 1972:


