

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 609

AN ORDINANCE, authorizing and directing the City Attorney to institute foreclosure proceedings as to certain delinquent local improvement district assessment liens in LID No. 63-ST-9 and LID No. 69-ST-14, under the alternate procedure method of RCW Chapter 35.50.

WHEREAS, certain local improvement district installment payments as hereinafter set forth are delinquent according to the records of the City Treasurer of the City of Redmond, and

WHEREAS, RCW 35.50.220 et seq. provides an alternate procedure for the foreclosure of delinquent local improvement assessment liens by filing a complaint in the Superior Court for King County, Washington, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. City Attorney authorized to initiate alternative foreclosure proceedings. The City Attorney is hereby authorized and directed to institute foreclosure of the following delinquent local improvement district assessment liens under the alternative procedure pursuant to RCW 35.50.220 et seq.:

(Tax lot 99)
No. 69-ST-14, created by Ordinance No. 486, 1969	No. 1	South 200 feet of the north 1044.8 feet of the east half of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 2, Township 25 North, range 5 east, W.M., in King County, Washington, less portion for highway.

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.
