ORDINANCE NO. 618

AN ORDINANCE, making a supplemental appropriation to the 1973 Budget of \$75,000 within the Water and Sewer Fund from the proceeds of a loan by the Washington State Economic Assistance Authority.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Appropriation for expenditures from proceeds of loan. There is hereby appropriated within the Water and Sewer Fund, Account No. 403.000.244.100.00, the sum of \$75,000 from the proceeds of a loan in the same amount from the Washington State Economic Assistance Authority to be used in connection with the construction of sanitary sewer facilities along N.E. 116th Street and Willows Road pursuant to Resolution No. 313.

Section 2. Supplement to 1973 Budget. The appropriation for expenditures from the revenue source indicated by this ordinance shall constitute a part of the 1973 Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 603 as a supplement thereto.


Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 7th day of August, 1973.
