

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 670

AN ORDINANCE, relating to motor vehicles and traffic; and establishing parking restrictions on a portion of West Lake Sammamish Parkway N.E. (SR 901) within the City of Redmond, Washington.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO. ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking restricted. In order to relieve traffic congestion and facilitate the orderly movement and safety of traffic, including bicycle traffic, as provided in Section 10.52.170 of the Redmond Municipal Code, the stopping, standing and parking of vehicles is hereby restricted and prohibited at all times upon the westerly side of West Lake Sammamish Parkway N.E. (SR 901) from N.E. 20th Street to N.E. 51st Street.


Section 2. Signs to be erected. The city traffic engineer, in conjunction with state highway authorities on this portion of a city street forming a part of the state highway system and as provided in Section 10.52.200 of the Redmond Municipal Code, shall cause appropriate signs to be erected on such street, giving notice of the prohibition of parking thereon. When official signs are so erected and placed, no person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle in violation of the restrictions stated on such signs.

Section 3. Supplement to Traffic Code -- penalties. This ordinance and the parking restrictions set forth above, shall be in addition to and as a supplement and part of the Traffic Code of the City of Redmond and the penalties provided in Section 1.01.110 of the Redmond Municipal Code thereof shall apply to violations hereunder.

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law, subject to approval by the State Highway Commission as to this city street forming a part of the state highway system.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 7<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1973.
