

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 637

AN ORDINANCE, relating to library financing; providing for an emergency appropriation of \$4,000 in the Current Expense Fund for the Library Department under the general class maintenance and operation; providing for an appropriation of \$30,000 from Federal Revenue Sharing funds; providing for an additional \$97,000 from revenues received from King County; and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, an insufficient appropriation was made at the time of the adoption of the 1974 Budget under the Current Expense Fund, Library Department, account No. 001-004-572-200-42, which cannot have been reasonably anticipated at the time budget estimates were made, and the City Council finds an emergency therefore exists in the ability of the City to provide proper library financing and that such condition can be alleviated by the expenditure of funds in the estimated amount of \$4,000 to said fund and account; and

WHEREAS, there is an insufficient amount in the Library Construction Fund for the City portion of the construction costs of the joint City of Redmond-King County public library and the Council finds that an amount up to \$30,000 should be appropriated from unappropriated Federal Revenue Sharing funds; and that an additional \$97,000 should be appropriated from revenues to be received from King County; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Emergency appropriation. That an emergency is hereby declared to exist, which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time the estimates were made for the 1974 Budget, requiring an expenditure of \$4,000 in funds not provided for in said Budget; and the expenditure of \$4,000 is hereby authorized and appropriated out of the Current Expense Fund under the general class of maintenance and operation for the Library Department under account No. 001-004-572-200-42 in order to provide for said emergency.

Section 2. Payment of emergency appropriation. Said emergency expenditure shall be paid by the issuance of emergency warrants, to be paid from any moneys on hand in the City treasury in the Current Expense Fund not otherwise appropriated, including unanticipated revenues, or if there be insufficient money on hand in such fund, said warrants shall be registered and shall bear interest at the rate of 8 % per annum until called for and paid.

Section 3. Appropriation out of Federal Revenue Sharing funds. There is hereby appropriated from any unappropriated Federal Revenue Sharing funds to the Library Construction Fund the amount of \$30,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the additional expenditure required by the City in the construction and equipping of the joint City of Redmond-King County public library building.


Section 4. Additional appropriation from King County funds. There is hereby appropriated from additional funds to be received from King County to the Library Construction Fund the amount of \$97,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the additional expenditure required as the share of King County in the construction and equipping of the joint City of Redmond-King County public library building.

Section 5. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its publication in the manner provided by law.

INTRODUCED at a regular meeting of the City Council this 6 day of February, 1974.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 19 day of February, 1974.


