

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 640

AN ORDINANCE, relating to motor vehicles and traffic; and establishing parking restrictions on certain streets and highways within the City of Redmond, Washington; and repealing Ordinance 579.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking restricted. In order to relieve traffic congestion and facilitate the orderly movement and safety of traffic, as provided in Section 10.52.170 of the Redmond Municipal Code, the stopping, standing and parking of vehicles is hereby restricted upon those streets and highways listed and described in the attached Schedule of Parking Restrictions as therein indicated.

Section 2. Signs to be erected. The city traffic engineer, in conjunction with state highway authorities on those portions of such streets forming a part of the state highway system and as provided in Section 10.52.200 of the Redmond Municipal Code, shall cause appropriate signs to be erected on such streets, giving notice of the prohibition of parking thereon. When official signs are so erected and placed, no person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle in violation of the restrictions stated on such signs.


Section 3. Penalties. This ordinance shall constitute a part of the Traffic Code of the City of Redmond and the penalties provided in Section 1.01.110 of the Redmond Municipal Code thereof shall apply to violations hereunder.

Section 4. Repeal. Section 2 of Ordinance 521, passed March 17, 1970; Section 2 of Ordinance 586, passed December 7, 1971; and Ordinance 579, passed August 18, 1972, are each hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law, subject to approval by the State Highway Commission as to those portions of such streets forming a part of the state highway system.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 16 day of April, 1974.


