ORDINANCE NO. 645

AN ORDINANCE, relating to finances and making a supplemental appropriation from unanticipated revenues for the Police Department under the General Fund.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Supplemental appropriation for Police Department. There is hereby appropriated as a supplement to the 1974 Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 630, an estimated expenditure of \$20,539.00 for the Police Department under the General Fund (Account No. 001.007) from unanticipated revenues from a LEAA grant for a "Juvenile Relations Officer" program in an amount of \$9,854.00 and Federal funds from the Drug Enforcement Administration in the amount of \$10,685.00, as follows:

Salaries	\$14,452.00
Overtime	1,946.00
Personnel Benefits	2,712.00
Uniform & Clothing	347.00
Operating Supplies	882.00
Machinery & Equipment	200.00
Total	<u>\$20,539.00</u>


Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.
