

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 646

AN ORDINANCE, relating to motor vehicles and prohibiting leaving unattended children under the age of eight years therein while such vehicles are left parked or standing.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Unlawful to leave unattended children in parked or standing motor vehicle. No person, while operating or in charge of a motor vehicle, shall park or wilfully allow such vehicle to stand upon a public street, public way or in a place open to the public, leaving any child or children under the age of eight years unattended therein. For the purposes of this section, "unattended" shall mean where no responsible person over twelve years of age is physically present in such vehicle and has immediate control over such child or children or the person operating or in charge of such vehicle is not in the immediate vicinity where such child or children can be seen or heard by such person.

Section 2. Penalties. Violations shall be punished as provided in Section 1.01.110 of the Redmond Municipal Code.


Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.
