ORDINANCE NO. 651

AN ORDINANCE, adopting a Shoreline Master Program for the City of Redmond pursuant to RCW Chapter 90.58.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Shoreline Master Program adopted. That certain bound volume entitled "Redmond Shoreline Master Program," which was developed by the Citizens Advisory Committee for Shoreline Management created by Ordinance 612, approved and recommended by the Planning Commission to the City Council, and reviewed by the City Council on June 18, 1974, pursuant to RCW Chapter 90.58, is hereby adopted by this reference as the Shoreline Master Program for the City of Redmond. Three copies of the Redmond Shoreline Master Program have been filed and will be kept on file in the office of the City Clerk for use and examination by the public.

Section 2. Approval by Department of Ecology required. The Planning Director shall submit the Redmond Shoreline Master Program to the State of Washington Department of Ecology for its review and approval pursuant to RCW 90.58.090. The Master Program hereby adopted shall become effective when adopted or approved by the Department of Ecology as therein provided.


Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.
