

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 668

AN ORDINANCE, relating to motor vehicles and traffic; and establishing speed limits and parking restrictions on certain streets and highways within the City.

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined on the basis of engineering and traffic investigation studies that maximum speed limits upon certain streets and highways should be established at a rate of speed greater or less than that provided generally by state law for streets and highways within incorporated cities and towns, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Speed limits established on a certain street. The maximum speed limits set forth in the following schedule are hereby established as the reasonable and safe maximum speed limits to be effective at all times upon the street and highway listed and described:


Highway/Street Designation	Traffic Direction	From	To	Maximum Speed
148th Avenue N.E.	Northbound	S. City Limits	<u>N.E. 60 Street</u>	<u>40</u>
148th Avenue N.E.	Both Ways	<u>N.E. 60 Street</u>	Redmond/Kirkland Road (SR 901)	<u>35</u>

Section 2. Supplement to Traffic Code. This ordinance and the speed limits set forth above shall be in addition to and as a supplement to the Traffic Code (Title 10, Redmond Municipal Code) and shall amend speed restrictions previously established upon the street mentioned.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 5 day of November, 1974.
