

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 670

AN ORDINANCE, relating to finances and adopting a Supplemental Budget for 1974, for the Current Expense Fund to appropriate and provide for expenditures from unanticipated revenues.

WHEREAS, the City anticipates receiving \$32,000 in revenues to the City which were not anticipated at the time the 1974 budget was adopted by Ordinance No. 603, and it is necessary that these funds be appropriated for the year 1974 as a supplement to the 1974 budget; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Supplemental Budget for Current Expense Fund adopted. There is hereby adopted a Supplemental Budget for the City of Redmond for the Current Expense Fund and there is hereby appropriated from the assets and unanticipated revenues received by the City from revenue sharing funds, reimbursable CETA program funds and other revenues, the following expenditures for the budget year 1974, as a supplement to the 1974 budget adopted by Ordinance No. 603:

CURRENT EXPENSE FUND #001

- A. For reimbursable CETA program \$12,200
- B. For additional pay for volunteer firemen as a result of the Fair Labor Standards Act 3,500
- C. For the Parks Department from additional program revenues 3,800 \$19,500

STREET FUND #101

For reimbursable CETA program \$ 3,000


REVENUE SHARING FUND #199

For anticipated Medic I charges for balance of year \$ 9,500  
\$32,000

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its publication in the manner provided by law.
