## CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ordinance no. 695

AN ORDINANCE, relating to land use regulations and districts (zoning); and amending Section 17.56.250 of the Redmond Municipal Code to provide for sign banners by non-profit, charitable organizations.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 17.56.250 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

17.56.250 Location. The location of signs shall comply with the regulations stated below:

Signs may be located within setback areas;

Signs shall not interfere with the sight clear-(2) ance requirements of Section 17.46.150;

(3) Signs intended to provide overhead clearance shall

have a minimum vertical clearance of eight feet;

(4) Signs not intended to provide overhead clearance shall have a maximum vertical clearance of one foot;

(5) Signs mounted on structures other than buildings

- shall not project into street rights-of-way;
  (6) Signs mounted on buildings shall not project into street rights-of-way, except where a building wall is on a street property line, a sign may be mounted on and parallel to such wall with a sign structure thickness, measured from such wall, of not more than six inches;

  (7) All signs shall be on-site; provided, that non-

(8) No sign shall have a height of more than twelve feet above the top of a building on which it is placed, or forty feet above ground level, whichever is the greater; provided, that this regulation shall not apply to signs otherwise limited in height.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.
