

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 707

AN ORDINANCE, relating to finances and adopting a Supplemental Budget for 1976, for the Library Construction Fund to appropriate and provide for expenditures from unanticipated revenues.

WHEREAS, the City has received a gift of \$2,000 from the Redmond Lions Club to be used for landscaping in connection with the new public library, which revenue was not anticipated at the time the 1976 budget was adopted by Ordinance No. 701, and it is necessary that these funds be appropriated for the year 1976 as a supplement to the 1976 budget; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Supplemental Budget adopted. There is hereby adopted a Supplemental Budget for the City of Redmond for the Library Construction Fund and there is hereby appropriated from unanticipated revenues, the following revenues and expenditures for the budget year 1976, as a supplement to the 1976 budget adopted by Ordinance No. 701:

Unanticipated revenues from
gift by Redmond Lions Club \$2,000.00


Expenditures

For landscaping purposes \$2,000.00

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its publication in the manner provided by law.
