

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 712

AN ORDINANCE, relating to streets and highways; and changing street name of the Redmond-Kirkland Road to Redmond Way.

WHEREAS, the City has received requests to redesignate the name of that portion of the Redmond-Kirkland Road (SR 908) within the City limits to Redmond Way; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed such requests, has caused inquiries to be sent to residents on such street regarding a name change and has received only favorable responses; and deeming a street name change should be made in the public interest and for the public welfare in order to reduce confusion and provide continuity in the name of such street, Now, Therefore,


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. Street name changed. The name of that portion of the Redmond-Kirkland Road (SR 908) within the City limits of Redmond (which extends from its intersection with West Lake Sammamish Parkway N.E. (SR 901) to the west City limits) is hereby changed to and redesignated as Redmond Way.

2. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 7 day of March, 1976.


