

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 713

AN ORDINANCE, relating to the annexation of certain territory under Annexation No. A-75-5; and amending Section 1, Ordinance No. 699 to clarify the legal description thereof.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 699 was duly passed by the City Council and approved by the Mayor on November 18, 1975, annexing certain territory to the City of Redmond under Annexation No. A-75-5; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the legal description of said territory so annexed should be clarified in order to avoid any confusion of uncertainty, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The legal description, as contained in Section 1 of Ordinance No. 699, adopted November 18, 1975, is hereby clarified and corrected, and said Section 1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The west half of the west half of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter of section 36, township 26 north, range 5 east, W.M., King County, Washington, less County road, less the north 3.54 acres thereof.


Situate in King County, State of Washington.

Section 2. All other provisions, terms and conditions of Ordinance No. 699, except as expressly modified and amended hereby, shall be and remain in full force and effect.


Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law. The City Clerk shall file certified copies of this ordinance with the Office of the County Executive of King County, Washington, the Secretary of State and the Planning and Community Affairs Agency of the State of Washington.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 2 day of March, 1976.


