

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 715

AN ORDINANCE, relating to finances and adopting a Supplemental Budget for 1976, for the Current Expense Fund to appropriate and provide for expenditures from unanticipated funds.

WHEREAS, the City has the opportunity to acquire vacant land in the Viewpoint Area of the City near the plat of Pitcairn View for greenbelt purposes upon a favorable purchase price and the sum of \$4,000 will be required for expenditures therefor during the calendar year 1976, and there will be unanticipated revenues for 1976 to be appropriated for such purposes, and it is necessary that these funds be appropriated for the year 1976 as a supplement to the 1976 Budget, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Supplemental Budget adopted. There is hereby adopted a Supplemental Budget for the City of Redmond for the Current Expense Fund, and there is hereby appropriated from unanticipated revenues, the following revenues and expenditures for the budget year 1976, as a supplement to the 1976 budget adopted by Ordinance No. 701:

CURRENT EXPENSE FUND #001

Revenues

Unanticipated revenues \$4,000.00


Expenditures

For property acquisition (Greenbelt) \$4,000.00

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its publication in the manner provided by law.


