ORDINANCE NO. 740

AN ORDINANCE, relating to motor vehicles and traffic; and establishing certain parking restrictions within residential areas of the City.

WHEREAS, numerous complaints have been received from citizens concerning the parking of large trucks and vehicle combinations overnight or for extended periods in residential areas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined on the basis of engineering and traffic investigation studies that additional parking restrictions should be established upon streets and highways in residential areas within the City with respect to large vehicles exceeding a certain length; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Additional parking restrictions in residential areas - length restrictions. In order to relieve traffic congestion and facilitate the orderly movement and safety of traffic and pedestrians, as provided in Section 10.52.170 of the Redmond Municipal Code, the stopping, standing and parking of trucks and vehicle combinations exceeding 30 feet in total length for in excess of 6 hours is hereby restricted and prohibited upon streets in residential areas of the City. For the purposes of this ordinance, "residential areas" is defined as those portions of the City which are zoned and used for single family or multiple family residential purposes.

Section 2. Supplement to Traffic Code. This ordinance and the parking restrictions set forth above shall be in addition to and as a supplement to the Traffic Code (Title 10, Redmond Municipal Code).

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 7th day of December, 1976.
