ORIGINAL

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON ORDINANCE NO. 740

AN ORDINANCE, relating to motor vehicles and traffic; and establishing certain parking restrictions within residential areas of the City.

WHEREAS, numerous complaints have been received from citizens concerning the parking of large trucks and vehicle combinations overnight or for extended periods in residential areas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined on the basis of engineering and traffic investigation studies that additional parking restrictions should be established upon streets and highways in residential areas within the City with respect to large vehicles exceeding a certain length; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 2. <u>Supplement to Traffic Code</u>. This ordinance and the parking restrictions set forth above shall be in addition to and as a supplement to the Traffic Code (Title 10, Redmond Municipal Code).

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.
