ORDINANCE NO. 756

AN ORDINANCE, relating to buildings and structures (Minimum Housing Code for the City of Redmond); and amending Section 15.08.020 of the Redmond Municipal Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMONG DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Amendment. Section 15.08.020 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

15.08.020 Adoption. The Uniform Housing Code, 1976 Edition, published by the International Conference of Building Officials of 5360 South Workman Mill Road, Whittier, California, is adopted by reference and incorporated herein as if fully set forth at length herein as the minimum housing code for the city, providing minimum requirements for the protection of life, limb, health, property, safety and the welfare of the general public and the owners and occupants of residential buildings; defining unfit and substandard buildings or portions thereof by repair, rehabilitation, demolition or removal; and providing penalties for violations. Three copies of the Uniform Housing Code have been filed and will be maintained in the office of the city clerk for use and examination by the public.

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 5th day of April, 1977.
