ORDINANCE NO. 788

AN ORDINANCE, relating to finances; and amending Section 3.60.020 of the Redmond Municipal Code which relates to the Petty Cash and Change Revolving Fund.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Amendment. Section 3.60.020 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"3.60.020 Establishment of fund. The treasurer-comptroller is authorized and directed to establish the fund by check or by a warrant with an initial cash amount of five hundred dollars. The fund is not intended to be a budgetary item as such, but to be in the nature of a revolving account for expenditures of a minor nature which are chargeable to various departments and funds of the city.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days from the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 15th day of November, 1977.
