

ORDINANCE No. 80

An ordinance providing for the licensing and regulating of Punch Boards and Machines for merchandising and/or for prizes and/or cash prizes: And providing penalties for the violation thereof. Amending ordinance No.75.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Redmond:

Section No.1

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate within the Town of Redmond, any Punch Board or Merchandising machine (other than skill games) without first having obtained a license therefor from the Town Clerk, in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section No.2

The following license fee shall be paid in advance to the Town clerk of the Town of Redmond by all persons, firms or corporations desiring and securing the privilege of operating any Punch Boards or machines for merchandising and/or prizes and/or cash prizes:

(A) All Punch Boards, 5 % of the gross receipts thereof.

(B) All Merchandising and/or prizes and/or cash prize machines (other than skill games) Each, \$5.00 per month.

Section No.3

No Punch Board or Merchandising machine shall be in operation after this ordinance is in effect without having a sticker attached thereto showing the license fee paid, the date of such payment, and must have the signature of the Town clerk thereon, provided however that this ordinance shall not apply to Punch Boards ~~which are~~ that are in use when this ordinance takes effect.

Section No.4

The police authorities are hereby directed to have the provisions of this ordinance strictly enforced.

Section No.5

Penalties.

Any Person, Firm or Corporation violating any provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not more than \$300.00 or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than 90 days, or both.
