ORDINANCE NO. 801

AN ORDINANCE relating to offenses against the public order amending Section 9.04.250 and adding a new section to Chapter 9.04 of the Redmond Municipal Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 9.04.250 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.04.250 Riot, failure to disperse, and false reporting. The following statutes of the State of Washington are adopted by reference.

RCW 9A 84.010(1)(2)(b) Riot
RCW 9A 84.020 Failure to Disperse
RCW 9A 84.040 False Reporting

Section 2. New Section. There is hereby added to Chapter 9.04 of the Redmond Municipal Code a new section to read as follows:

Disorderly conduct. A person is guilty of disorderly conduct if he

(a) Uses abusive language and thereby intentionally creates a risk of assault; or

(b) Intentionally disrupts any lawful assembly or meeting of persons without authority; or

(c) Intentionally obstructs vehicular or pedestrian traffic without lawful authority;


(d) Intentionally and without lawful authority makes noise which unreasonably disturbs another or

(e) Intentionally engages in any conduct which tends to or does disturb the public peace, provoke disorder or endanger the safety of others.


Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 20th day of December, 1977.


