ORDINANCE NO. 803

AN ORDINANCE, relating to and regulating motor vehicles, traffic, travel and transportation and their incidents upon the public streets and ways open to travel within the City of Redmond; adopting state statutes by reference; and repealing Ordinance 482, Section 1 of Ordinance 457, Section 1 of Ordinance 417, and Sections 126 and 127 of Ordinance 304.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:
