1978 Supplemental Budget

CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 806

AN ORDINANCE, relating to finances and adopting a Supplemental Budget for 1978 for the Current Expense Fund (001) to appropriate and provide for expenditures from unanticipated revenues, cash balances, grant receipts and fund transfers.

WHEREAS, the cost and expense of the construction of a City shop storage building is expected to exceed the amounts provided in the expenditures for the 1978 Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 789, which additional expense could not have been reasonably anticipated when the 1978 Budget was adopted; and

WHEREAS, the City anticipates receiving \$25,000 in revenues to the City which were not anticipated at the time the 1978 budget was adopted by Ordinance No. 789; and it is necessary that these funds be appropriated for the year 1978 as a supplement to the 1978 budget; Now Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Supplemental Budget adopted. There is hereby adopted a Supplemental Budget for the City of Redmond for the Current Expense Fund (001), and there is hereby appropriated from unanticipated revenues received by the city cash balances, grant receipts, fund transfers, and other unappropriated revenues, the following expenditures for the budget year 1978, as a supplement to the 1978 Budget adopted by Ordinance No. 789:

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its publication in the manner provided by law.
