ORDINANCE NO. 809

AN ORDINANCE, relating to licenses for peddlers; and amending Sections 5.08.020 and 5.08.030 of the Redmond Municipal Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 5.08.020 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.08.020 License required--Exceptions. It is unlawful for any person to hawk or peddle any goods, wares, or merchandise within the limits of the city without first obtaining a license as a peddler or hawker as provided in this chapter; provided that no person shall be required to take out a license or pay a fee for the peddling of newspapers, magazines or other periodicals; and provided further, that no license shall be required of any person to peddle fruits, vegetables, berries, butter, eggs, fish, milk, poultry, meats, or any farm produce or edibles raised, caught, produced or manufactured by such person in any place in this state.


Section 2. Amendment. Section 5.08.030 of the Redmond Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

5.08.030 Application--Fee. Every peddler or hawker, whether principal or agent, shall, before commencing business in the city, make application in writing and under oath to the city clerk for a license and pay a license fee of one hundred dollars per year; provided that bona fide charitable or non-profit organizations which have registered with the state under RCW Chapter 19.09 (Charitable Solicitations) shall be exempt from the payment of any license fee hereunder upon furnishing proof of such registration to the city clerk.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its publication in the manner provided by law.
