CITY OF REDMOND, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 821

AN ORDINANCE annexing certain non-contiguous unincorporated territory in King County, Washington, owned by the City of Redmond, to the corporate limits of the City, under Annexation No. A-76-3 for municipal purposes pursuant to RCW 35A.14.300.

WHEREAS, the City is the owner of approximately 70 acres of non-contiguous real property located outside the city limits of Redmond known as the "Farrel - Mc Whirter Park," which property is now owned, used and operated by the City of Redmond for municipal park purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, by Resolution No. 402, passed July 6, 1976, declared its intention to annex such territory to the City pursuant to RCW 35A.14.300; and

WHEREAS, the proposed annexation was duly filed with the Boundary Review Board of King County, Washington, (BRB No. 745) and said Board thereafter advised the City that no request for review had been received and that on February 18, 1978, the annexation was deemed approved pursuant to RCW 36.93.100; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council that the proposed annexation of the territory described below will be for the general benefit of the City of Redmond and the general benefit of the area to be annexed, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Territory annexed -- description. The following described territory, situated in King County, State of Washington, is hereby annexed to the City of Redmond, Washington, to wit:

That portion of the Southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 31, Township 26 north, range 6 east, W.M.; except the west 30 feet thereof, except the north 200 feet thereof, and except that portion thereof lying within 196th Ave. N.E.

Also the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter; except the west 30 feet thereof and except that portion of said subdivision lying southeasterly of the northwesterly margin of Redmond Road No. 1133;

All situate in King County, Washington


Section 2. Effective date of annexation. The above described territory shall be annexed to and become a part of the City of Redmond for all purposes on and after May 1, 1978, which shall be the effective date of this annexation.

Section 3. Certified copies to be furnished and filed. The Planning Director shall file certified copies of this ordinance with the Office of the County Executive of King County, Washington, and shall obtain and file in duplicate with the State Census Board the required certificate relating to determining the population of the annexed area. Certified copies of this ordinance shall also be transmitted to the Secretary of State and the Planning and Community Affairs Agency of the State of Washington.

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 18th day of April, 1978.


