ORDINANCE NO. 831

AN ORDINANCE, vacating an unimproved dedicated public right-of-way in the Plat of Wildwood Glen No. 1, within the City of Redmond, King County, Washington.

WHEREAS, a written Petition for the Vacation of Right-of-Way, signed by in excess of two-thirds of the property owners abutting thereon, was filed with the City Clerk and presented to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council by Resolution No. 463 set the date of June 20, 1978, at 8:00 P.M., at the City Hall, before the City Council, as the time, place and authority for a public hearing to be held on said Petition; and

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of such hearing has been made in accordance with law; and

WHEREAS, the hearing having been duly held, there being no objections by any of the abutting property owners, and the City Council having determined that it is in the best interest of the City and the property owners concerned that such public right-of-way be vacated, Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDMOND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Right-of-Way vacation granted. That the Petition be granted, and the following described public right-of-way is hereby declared vacated:

Tract "A" Wildwood Glen No. 1, as per plat thereof recorded in Volume 91, page 29 of Plats, records of King County, Washington.


Situate in the City of Redmond, King County, Washington.

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after the date of its publication in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Council of the City of Redmond, Washington, at a regular meeting thereof, and APPROVED by the Mayor this 5TH day of July, 1978.


